<u>Minutes of "Technical Bid Evaluation for selection of Third Party Agencies for</u> <u>Monitoring, Evaluation, Learning & Documentation (MEL&D) under WDC-PMKSY</u> <u>2.0" held on 3rd May, 2023 at 11:00 am at the Office of CEO, SLNA, 4th floor, R.G.</u> Baruah Road, Guwahati- 5

A meeting was held at the Office of Chief Executive Officer, SLNA, Assam for final Technical Evaluation of Third party Agencies for MEL&D under WDC-PMKSY 2.0 vide letter No. SLNA/WDC-PMKSY/45/2022/469 dt. 2nd May, 2023 under the Chairmanship of CEO, SLNA.

2. As per the General Evaluation in the EOI stage by the Committee, 6 (Six) numbers of Consultancy Services/Agencies were qualified for RFP stage i.e. for Technical & Financial Bid. The eligible 6 Bidders are as follows:

- Adarsh Saraswati Mahila Siksha and Gramin Vikash Samiti, Rajasthan
- Athena Infonomics pvt. Ltd., Chennai
- AFC India Ltd., New Delhi
- NEDFi, Assam
- The Energy & Resource Institute (TERI), Assam
- VISION EIS Pvt. Ltd, Noida, UP

3. The Technical Bids were opened on 12th April, 2023 and scrutinize by the Technical Committee as per the criteria laid down in the RFP document as per the order No. SLNA/WDC-PMKSY/45/2022/466 dt. 13th April, 2023.

4. Also, as per the Criteria No.4 of ITC 2.23.1 of RFP document, a Technical Presentation on process/methodology by the agencies was held on 28th April, 2023 *vide* letter No. SLNA/WDC-PMKSY/45/2022/467 dt. 25th April, 2023.

5. Finally, a comparative statement was prepared as per Terms & condition called for in the RFP document. The Technical bid Score (St) are listed as below:-
