#### Abstract

minutes of the first meeting of the steering committee on WATERSHED DEVELOPMENT COMPONENT OF PRADHAN MANTRI KRISHI SINCHAYEE YOJANA (WDC-2.0) HELD ON 04.01.2022 UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SECRETARY (LR) IN THE COMMITTEE ROOM, NBO BUILDING, NIRMAN BHAVAN, NEW DELHI


The first meeting of the Steering Committee on Watershed Development Component of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (WDC 2.0) [here in after referred as Committee] was held on 04.01.2022 under the Chairmanship of Secretary, DoLR in the Committee Room, NBO Building, Nirman Bhavan, New Delhi. The list of participants is at Annexure I.
2. The meeting was initiated by Additional Secretary (DoLR) by welcoming the participants and apprising them about the agenda of meeting. He informed the members about the approval of Government of India on WDC-PMKSY 2.0 for 5 years from 2021-22 to 2025-26. He underscored the importance of GIS-based planning in projects and plantations (horticulture/afforestation) in project areas as desired by Hon'ble Minister of Rural Development (MoRD). He also emphasized on total compliance with PFMS SNA module by all States/UTs as per the extant instructions of Ministry of Finance.
3. The Chairman emphasized on the significance of WDC 2.0 projects for the Government as evident from Hon'ble Prime Minister's interaction with Secretaries on 18.9.2021. He stated that in WDC 1.0, GIS was used only at Monitoring \& Evaluation stage; but now the GIS technology has to be used right in the planning stage itself for precise selection of project areas based on scientific analysis. He also exhorted the States/UTs to undertake large scale remunerative horticultural plantations in all project areas as per the directives of Hon'ble MoRD to enhance farmers' income in order to achieve Government's target of DFI (Doubling of Farmers' Income). The Chairman appraised the members that cost norms have been substantially increased in WDC 2.0 vis-à-vis WDC 1.0 i.e. from Rs.12,000/15,000 to Rs.22,000/28,000 per hectare respectively for effective implementation of works. Springshed Development activities have also been included in WDC 2.0 for Himalayan/mountainous regions. Thereafter, he stressed on the vital mandatory requirements for projects to be taken up under WDC 2.0 as given below:
(i) For plain areas, minimum area proposed for treatment in each project should be 2500 ha.
(ii) For hilly areas, minimum area proposed for treatment in each project should be 1500 ha. However, in exceptional cases, projects with area not less than 1000 ha may be allowed with detailed justification note submitted by the State concerned to DoLR.
(iii) All PPR should be approved by Chairman, SLSC.
(iv) Aspirational Districts should be given priority.
(v) 40 identified backward Blocks in North-Eastern Region should be given priority.
(vi) Area from DoLR-transferred projects of WDC-PMKSY 1.0 for implementation with States/UTs budget, should not be included in the proposed projects.
(vii) All DPRs should be finalized preferably by 31.1.2022.
(viii) All DPRs should be based on GIS planning.
(ix) As far as possible, $20 \%$ of the project area should be covered with large scale plantations (horticulture/afforestation).
4. Joint Secretary (WM) made a PPT presentation highlighting the achievements of WDC 1.0 and salient features of WDC 2.0 such as, reduction of project period from 4-7 years to 3-5 years, hike in cost norms, springshed activities, climate change adaptations, more biological measures, effective use of rain water, Farmer Producers Organization (FPO), Integrated Farming System (IFS) etc. A copy of the PPT is enclosed as Annexure II.
5. After that, the State/UT-wise presentation of proposals by 24 States and 2 UTs were made before Steering Committee in the following order:

Andhra Pradesh: The Director, SLNA, Andhra Pradesh made the presentation on performance of the WDC 1.0 projects and proposal for appraisal of new projects under WDC 2.0. State has proposed 61 projects covering an area of 2.49 lakh hectare against the allocated target of 2.447 lakh hectare. In addition State has also proposed 26 additional projects covering an area of 1.16 lakh hectare. State has

informed that no transferred project area has been included in the proposed 61 projects against the allocated target area of 2.447 lakh ha.

During the presentation, State informed that they have completed batch I to batch III projects and submitted end-line evaluation reports. Batch IV and V projects are ongoing. State has been advised to complete all ongoing projects by January, 2022 and submit End-line Evaluation reports by March, 2022. State has also been advised to utilize full amount of unspent balance of Rs. 69.70 crore available with State by February 2022.

## Decision of the Committee:

After detailed deliberations, Committee appraised and sanctioned the proposals of State for the projects covering an area 2.447 lakh ha only,subject to following corrections:
(i) Minimum size of the proposed project should not be less than 2500 ha
(ii) The weightage of proposed project should be atleast 75 .
(iii) Submission of proposal with the approval of Chairman, SLSC.

State has now corrected as per the above suggestions and furnished the corrected list of projects covering 2.444 lakh ha, except submission of approval of the proposal by chairman, SLSC. Details of the projects appraised and sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

The sanction of these projects has been considered by the Committee subject to approval of Chairman, SLSC and submission of the same to DoLR.

Chhattisgarh: The Additional CEO, SLNA made a presentation on performance of the WDC PMKSY 1.0 projects and proposals for appraisal of new projects to be taken under WDC PMKSY 2.0. State has proposed 50 projects covering an area of 2.52 lakh ha against the allocated target of 2.504 lakh ha. State has informed that no transferred project area has been included in the proposed 50 projects against the allocated target area of 2.52 lakh ha.

During the presentation, State informed that they have completed batch I to batch III projects and submitted end-line evaluation reports Batch I and batch II only. The
State representative assured to submit end-line evaluation Reports of Batch III by March, 2022. Batch IV projects are ongoing. State has been advised to complete all ongoing projects by January, 2022 and submit End-line Evaluation reports by March, 2022. State has informed that they have unspent balance of Rs. 46 crore available including Rs. 10 crore of interest. State has been advised to return the interest amount immediately to Col and the balance should be utilized fully by January, 2022 for completion of ongoing projects.

## Decision of the Committee:

After detailed deliberations, the Committee appraised and sanctioned the proposals of State for the projects covering an area 2.504 lakh ha only subject to following corrections:
(i) Minimum size of the proposed project should not be less than 2500 ha
(ii) The weightage of proposed project should be atleast 75 .

State has now corrected as per the above suggestions and furnished corrected list of projects covering 2.504 lakh ha. Details of the projects appraised and sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Karnataka: The Commissioner and CEO, SLNA, Karnataka made a presentation on performance of the WDC 1.0 projects and proposal for appraisal of new projects under WDC 2.0. State has proposed 57 projects covering an area of 2.76 lakh hectare against the allocated target of 2.75 lakh hectare. In addition State has also proposed 16 additional projects covering an area of 0.80 lakh hectare. State has informed that some transferred project area has been included in the proposed 57 projects against the allocated target area of 2.75 lakh ha.

While making presentation, State informed that they have completed all projects of Batch I to Batch III \& 12 projects Batch IV and submitted end-line evaluation reports of these projects. State has assured that the balance Batch IV project will be completed by January, 2022 and submit End-line Evaluation reports by March, 2022.

State has also been advised to utilize full amount of unspent balance of Rs.5.98 crore available with State.

## Decision of the Committee:

After detailed deliberations, Committee appraised and sanctioned the proposals of State for the projects covering an area 2.75 lakh ha only subject to following corrections:
(i) Transferred projects area should be excluded in the proposed projects against the allocated target of 2.75 lakh ha.
(ii) Rechecking of the weightage of proposed projects.

State has now corrected as per the above suggestions and furnished corrected list of projects covering 2.75 lakh ha. Details of the projects appraised and sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Madhya Pradesh: The Secretary RD \& PR and Joint Commissioner, SLNA made a presentation on performance of the WDC PMKSY 1.0 projects and proposals for appraisal of new projects to be taken under WDC PMKSY 2.0. State has proposed 82 projects covering an area of 4.95 lakh ha against the allocated target of 4.946 lakh ha. In addition State has also proposed 20 additional projects covering an area of 1.26 lakh hectare. State has informed that no transferred project area has been included in the proposed 82 projects against the allocated target area of 4.946 lakh ha.

While presenting proposal, State informed that they have completed all ongoing projects of WDC 1.0 and submitted end-line evaluation reports Batch I to batch III. The State representative assured to submit end-line evaluation Reports of Batch IV to VI by March, 2022. State has informed that they have unspent balance of Rs. 12.46 crore available. State has been advised to assess fund requirement for formal completion and evaluation of the projects and return the remaining amount immediately to Gol.

## Decision of the Committee:

After detailed deliberations, Committee appraised and sanctioned the proposals of State for the projects covering allocated target area 4.946 lakh hectares only, subject to correction of total proposed project area equal to the allocated area. State has now submitted corrected list of projects as per the suggestions of the Committee. Details of the projects appraised and sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Maharashtra: The Additional CEO, SLNA made a presentation on performance of the WDC PMKSY 1.0 projects and proposals for appraisal of new projects to be taken under WDC PMKSY 2.0. State has proposed 67 projects covering an area of 2.45 lakh ha against the allocated target of 5.65 lakh ha. State has informed that no transferred project area has been included in the proposed 67 projects covering an area of 2.45 lakh ha.

While presenting proposal, State informed that they have completed batch I to batch III projects and submitted end-line evaluation reports. The projects of Batch IV to VI are ongoing. The State has been advised to complete all these projects by utilizing unspent balance of Rs. 411.16 available with State as on 31.12 .2021 . Further committee observed that the pace of expenditure in the State is extremely slow and expressed their serious concern about it. Accordingly, State representative has been requested to make a fair assessment of actual fund utilization by March, 2022 and return the balance immediately to DoLR. State has also been advised to prepare a calendar of operation for remaining three months for completion ongoing projects and ensure to submit all requisite documents to DoLR by March, 2022.

## Decision of the Committee:

After detailed deliberations, committee appraised and sanctioned the proposals of State for the projects covering an area 2.45 lakh ha only subject to following corrections.
(i) Minimum size of the proposed project should not be less than 2500 ha.
(ii) The weightage of proposed project should be atleast 75 .

State has corrected as per the above suggestions and furnished corrected list of projects covering 2.45 lakh ha. Details of the projects appraised and sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Odisha: The CEO, SLNA, Odisha made a presentation on performance of the WDC 1.0 projects and proposal for appraisal of new projects under WDC 2.0. State has proposed 50 projects covering an area of 2.81 lakh hectare against the allocated target of 2.785 lakh hectare. In addition State has also proposed 12 additional projects covering an area of 0.68 lakh hectare. State has informed that no transferred project area has been included in the proposed 50 projects against the allocated target area of 2.785 lakh ha.

While making presentation, State informed that they have completed all projects of Batch I to Batch III \& 12 projects Batch IV and submitted end-line evaluation reports of Batch I to III projects only. State has assured that the balance Batch IV project will be completed by January, 2022 and submit End-line Evaluation reports by March, 2022. State has informed that they have unspent balance of Rs.19.70 crore available including Rs. 6.40 crore of interest. Out of which Rs.17.86 crore pertains to Batch I \& II. State has been advised to return the interest amount and Batch I \& II unspent balance immediately to Gol and the balance should be utilized fully by January, 2022 for completion of ongoing projects.

## Decision of the Committee:

After detailed deliberations, committee appraised and sanctioned the proposals of State for the projects covering allocated target area of 2.785 lakh hectares only subject to correction of total proposed project area equal to the allocated area. State has now submitted corrected list of projects as per the suggestions of the Committee. Details of the projects appraised and sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Rajasthan: The Additional CEO, SLNA and Joint Director, SLNA made a presentation on performance of the WDC 1.0 projects and proposal for appraisal of new projects under WDC 2.0. State has proposed 155 projects covering an area of 7.88 lakh hectare against the allocated target of 7.50 lakh hectare. In addition State
has also proposed 40 additional projects covering an area of 2.09 lakh hectare. State has informed that some transferred projects area has been included in the proposed 155 projects against the allocated target area of 7.50 lakh ha.

During the presentation, State informed that they have completed all projects of Batch I to Batch III projects and submitted end-line evaluation reports. State has assured that the Batch IV \& V projects will be completed and End-line Evaluation reports will be submitted by March, 2022. State has informed that they have unspent balance of Rs.57.63 crore. State has been advised to expedite utilization of unspent balance by January, 2022 for completion of ongoing projects.

## Decision of the Committee:

After detailed deliberations, Committee appraised and sanctioned the proposals of State for the projects covering an area 7.50 lakh ha only subject to following corrections:
(i) Transferred projects area should be excluded from the proposed projects against the allocated target of 7.50 lakh ha.
(ii) Rechecking of the weightage of proposed projects.

State has now corrected as per the above suggestions and furnished corrected list of projects covering 7.497 lakh ha. Details of the projects appraised and sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Assam: The CEO, SLNA Assam made a presentation on the progress of ongoing watershed projects of Department of Land Resources in the State. The State has proposed to take up new projects covering a total area of 1.29 lakh ha against the tentative allocation of 1.31 lakh ha allocated by DoLR. Along with this, State has also proposed allocation of additional area for 0.57 lakh ha.

While presenting to the Steering Committee, CEO, SLNA Assam informed that the State Government has completed all projects upto Batch-IV and End-line evaluation of Batch-IV projects is under process. Batch-V \& VI projects were transferred to State Govt.


State has informed that Rs. 39.88 crore is available as unspent balance as on 31.12.2021. AS\&FA, MoRD has advised the State to return the amount to DoLR after deducting amount to be paid for committed liability.

State was also requested to increase afforestation and plantation activities through horticulture alongwith livelihood and production system activities under WDC 2.0. State was advised to recheck and reassess weightage given to the proposed projects namely Darrang-II, Goalpara-II, Morigaon-I, Nagaon-I and Hojai-I as cumulative weighate of these projects are less than 75 . The same has been rectified now by the State in their revised list.

## Decision of the Committee:

The Committee deliberated upon the proposal of the State Government and appraised \& sanctioned an area of 128574 ha for treatment under WDC 2.0. The list of projects appraised and sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Arunachal Pradesh: The Secretary, RD, Arunachal Pradesh in their presentation intimated that all projects upto Batch-IV have been completed. However, as per record available in the Department 32 projects of Batch-II, 28 projects of Batch-III and 18 projects of Batch-IV are pending for completion.

The State has proposed to take up new projects covering a total area of 1.46 lakh ha against the tentative allocation of 1.46 lakh ha allocated by DoLR. While reviewing the individual project details, it was noticed that State has proposed many projects having project area less than 1000 ha; even some projects are having project area of 300 ha. Committee has advised that all the projects area in hilly States should be more than 1500 ha. In exceptional cases only, it can be between 1000 ha to 1500 ha with proper justification from the State Govt.

AS\&FA, MoRD pointed out that State is still not having separate State share budget head which is now one of the mandatory criteria as per the latest Guidelines on FMS.


## Decision of the Committee:

State has been advised to resubmit their PPRs taking into account the stipulations on minimum project area, for consideration in the next meeting of Steering Committee. State is also advised to include aspirational districts, PMO identified backward blocks in NER in the revised PPRs. State needs to submit all project completion reports of WDC 1.0 projects by 15th Jan 2022 and all end-line reports by March 2022.

Bihar: The CEO, SLNA Bihar made a presentation on the progress of ongoing watershed projects of Department of Land Resources in the State. The State has proposed to take up new projects covering a total area of 1.67 lakh ha against the tentative allocation of 1.67 lakh ha allocated by DoLR and an additional area of 0.46 lakh ha.

While presenting to the Steering Committee, CEO, SLNA Bihar informed that the State Government has completed all Batch- III \& IV projects and End-line evaluation reports have also been submitted. Batch-V \& VI projects were transferred to State Govt.

State has informed that Rs. 31.05 crore is available as unspent balance as on 31.12.2021. AS\&FA, MoRD advised the State to return the amount to DoLR after deducting amount to be paid for committed liability.

State was also advised to give thrust on plantation activities and improve the expenditure on production systems, under WDC 2.0.

The committee observed that State has identified all KVKs for taking up capacity building activities, under WDC-2.0. As KVKs do not possess the required expertise for watershed projects, therefore, the Committee advised the State to identify some good ICAR institutes and other relevant organizations, for the purpose.

## Decision of the Committee:

The Committee deliberated upon the proposal of the State Government and appraised \& sanctioned an area of 1,66,361 ha for treatment under WDC 2. The list of projects appraised and sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Kerala: The CEO, SLNA Kerala made a presentation on the progress of ongoing watershed projects of Department of Land Resources in the State. State is still having unspent balance of Rs. 39.70 crore, which includes Rs. 12.30 core still to be transferred to SLNA account by the State Govt. Chair and AS\&FA, MoRD have raised a serious concern on delay of transfer of funds from State Govt. to SLNA, which is pending for last 2 years.

The State has proposed to take up new projects covering a total area of 0.26 lakh ha against the tentative allocation of 0.26 lakh ha allocated by DoLR. Along with this, State has also proposed allocation of additional area for 0.074 lakh ha.

Proposal received from SLNA, Kerala was without having approval of Chairman, SLSC. Approval of Chairman SLSC on file has been received now.

## Decision of the Committee:

The Committee deliberated upon the proposal of the State Government and appraised \& sanctioned 6 projects covering an area of 26,163 ha in 6 Districts of Kerala for treatment under WDC 2.0. The list of projects appraised sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Manipur: The CEO, SLNA Manipur made a presentation on the progress of ongoing watershed projects of Department of Land Resources in the State. The State has proposed to take up new projects covering a total area of 0.587 lakh ha against the tentative allocation of 0.587 lakh ha allocated by DoLR. Along with this, State has also proposed allocation of additional area for 0.18 lakh ha.

While presenting to the Steering Committee, CEO, SLNA Manipur informed that only one project of Batch-IV is pending for completion, for which completion and End-line reports will be sent within 15 days.

Committee observed that there is requirement of improvement in Institutional Capacity at WCDC and PIA level.


## Decision of the Committee:

The Committee deliberated upon the proposal of the State Government and appraised \& sanctioned 13 projects covering an area of 58690 ha for treatment under WDC 2.0. The list of projects appraised sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Meghalaya: The Director cum CEO, Soil and Water Conservation Department, Meghalaya made a presentation on the progress of ongoing watershed projects in the State. The CEO proposed to take up new projects covering a total area of 0.566 lakh ha against the tentative target of 0.547 lakh ha allocated by DoLR under WDC 2.0. Along with this, State has also proposed allocation of additional area for 0.052 lakh ha.

State has informed that some projects proposed under WDC2.0 are having area from the projects transferred to State Govt. under WDC 1.0. State in its revised list removed the project areas of WDC 1.0.

Proposals received from SLNA, Meghalaya were without having approval of Chairman, SLSC. Approval of Chairman, SLSC however has been submitted now.

Committee has noticed that there is need to strengthen Institutional setup for implementation of projects.

While reviewing the individual project details, it was noticed that State has proposed few projects having project area less than 1500 ha. Committee has advised that all the projects area in hilly States should be more than 1500 ha, in exceptional cases it can be between 1000 ha to 1500 ha with proper justification from the State Govt. It was also observed that weightage mentioned in one of the project i.e. East Garo Hills -III is 150 , which is higher than the permissible weightage of 135. State required to recheck it. State in its revised list corrected the weightage to 110 from 150.

Since all the projects have been completed, AS\&FA, MoRD has advised State to return the unspent balance including interest funds to Govt. of India by 15 th January, 2022.


## Decision of the Committee:

The Committee deliberated upon the proposal of the State Government and appraised \& sanctioned 28 projects covering an area of 54,730 for treatment under WDC 2.0. The list of projects appraised sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Mizoram: The CEO, SLNA Mizoram made a presentation on the progress of ongoing watershed projects in the State. The CEO proposed to take up new projects covering a total area of 0.446 lakh ha against the tentative target of 0.458 lakh ha allocated by DoLR under WDC 2.0. Along with this, State has also proposed allocation of additional area for 0.145 lakh ha.

Committee has noticed that there is need to strengthen Institutional setup for implementation of projects.

While reviewing the individual project details, it was noticed that State has considered different weightage criteria which needs correction. State in its revised list sent corrected weightage criteria duly signed by CEO, SLNA. Weightage to all the projects are now more than 75 .

State was also requested to increase afforestation and plantation activities through horticulture under WDC 2.0.

## Decision of the Committee:

The Committee deliberated upon the proposal of the State Government and appraised \& sanctioned 18 projects covering an area of 44,600 ha for treatment under WDC 2.0. The list of projects appraised and sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Nagaland: The CEO, SLNA Nagaland made a presentation on the progress of ongoing watershed projects of Department of Land Resources in the State and intimated that State has completed all its projects alongiwith End-line evaluation within the prescribed project duration and none of the project were transferred to State. It was also informed that State has dedicated department with the
nomenclature of 'Department of Land Resources' to implement watershed projects in State.

The State has proposed to take up new projects covering a total area of 0.20 lakh ha against the tentative allocation of 0.20 lakh ha allocated by DoLR. Alongwith this, State has also proposed allocation of additional area for 0.42 lakh ha.

Since area allocated to State is very less, considering the past performance State and taking into account that there is well established Institutional Setup for implementation of projects from first day of launching, State has requested the Chair to allocate additional projects.

## Decision of the Committee:

The Committee deliberated upon the proposal of the State Government and appraised \& sanctioned 5 projects covering an area of 20000 ha for treatment under WDC 2.0. The list of projects appraised and sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Sikkim: The It. Resident Commissioner alongwith CEO, SLNA Sikkim made a presentation on the progress of ongoing watershed projects of Department of Land Resources in the State.

The State has proposed to take up new projects covering a total area of 0.212 lakh ha against the tentative allocation of 0.20 lakh ha allocated by DoLR. Alongwith this, State has also proposed allocation of additional area for 0.067 lakh ha.

Proposal received from SLNA, Sikkim was without having approval of Chairman, SLSC.

## Decision of the Committee:

The Committee deliberated upon the proposal of the State Government and appraised \& sanctioned 6 projects covering an area of 20,000 ha for treatment under


WDC 2.0 subject to approval of Chairman SLSC. The list of projects appraised \& sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Tamil Nadu: The CEO, SLNA Tamil Nadu made a presentation on the progress of ongoing watershed projects of Department of Land Resources in the State and intimated that State has completed all its projects alongiwith End-line evaluation and none of the project were transferred to State.

State has informed that interest amount to Rs. 49.42 crore is available as unspent balance as on 31.12.2021. AS\&FA, MoRD has advised the State to return the interest amount to DoLR.

The State has proposed to take up new projects covering a total area of 1.30 lakh ha against the tentative allocation of 1.30 lakh ha allocated by DoLR. Alongwith this, State has also proposed allocation of additional area for 0.357 lakh ha. State was also requested to increase afforestation and plantation activities through horticulture alongwith livelihood and production system activities under WDC 2.0.

## Decision of the Committee:

The Committee deliberated upon the proposal of the State Government and appraised \& sanctioned 27 projects covering an area of 1,30,330 ha for treatment under WDC 2.0. The list of projects appraised \& sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Tripura: The CEO, SLNA Tripura made a presentation on the progress of ongoing watershed projects of Department of Land Resources in the State. The State has proposed to take up new projects covering a total area of 20,108 ha against the tentative allocation of 20,000 ha allocated by DoLR. Along with this, State has also proposed allocation of additional area for 5,396 ha. State in its revised list modified total project to be 20,000 ha.

While presenting to the Steering Committee, CEO, SLNA Tripura informed that the State Government has completed all projects upto Batch-V and End-line evaluation of Batch-V projects will be submitted by February,2022. Batch-VI projects were

transferred to State Govt. However, as per record available in the Department 8 projects of Batch- V are pending for completion.

Committee has noticed that there is need to strengthen Institutional setup for implementation of projects.

While reviewing the individual project details, it was noticed that State has proposed many projects having project area less than 1500 ha. Committee advised that all the projects area in hilly States should be more than 1500 ha, in exceptional cases it can be between 1000 ha to 1500 ha with proper justification from the State Govt. State in its revised list modified and kept minimum area as 1500 ha.

## Decision of the Committee:

The Committee deliberated upon the proposal of the State Government and appraised \& sanctioned 13 projects covering an area of 20,000 ha for treatment under WDC 2.0. The list of projects appraised \& sanctioned are enclosed at

## Annexure III.

Jharkhand: The CEO, SLNA Jharkhand made a presentation on the progress of ongoing watershed projects of Department of Land Resources in the State. The State has proposed to take up new projects covering a total area of 1.54 lakh ha against the tentative allocation of 1.48 lakh ha allocated by DoLR and an additional area of 1.61 lakh ha.

While presenting to the Steering Committee, CEO, SLNA informed that the State Government has completed all projects upto Batch- III. Batch IV \& V projects are still under progress. End-line evaluation reports have also been submitted for Batch I \& II. Batch-VI projects were transferred to State Govt.

State has informed that Rs. 117.96 crore is available as unspent balance as on 31.12.2021. AS\&FA, MoRD advised the State to return the amount after deducting amount to be paid for the committed liability. Also State Govt. needs to make a plan
for utilization of unspent balance and submit the completion of ongoing projects by 31st January 2022 followed by the submission of End-line reports by March,2022.

State was also advised to give thrust on plantation activities and improve the expenditure on production systems, under WDC 2.0.

Proposal received from SLNA, Jharkhand is without having approval of Chairman, SLSC.

Committee noticed that there is a need to strengthen Institutional setup for implementation of projects.

## Decision of the Committee:

The Committee deliberated upon the proposal of the State Government and appraised \& sanctioned an area of $1,48,000$ ha for treatment under WDC 2 subject to approval of Chairman, SLSC. State needs to return unspent balance after deducting amount to be paid for committed liability. The list of projects appraised \& sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Jammu \& Kashmir: The CEO, SLNA made the presentation in respect of 19 projects covering an area of 71,431 ha against an area of 69,493 ha allocated by DoLR. In addition to the allocated area, the UT also presented 13 projects covering an area of 51,726 ha.

The Chairman asked the UT representative to get institutional preparedness by 31.01.2022. He also observed that area under plantations has to be considerably increased. It was also pointed out that expenditures under the components of Livelihood ( $0.17 \%$ ) and Production systems ( $1.69 \%$ ) were abysmally low whereas the expenditure under Administrative Expenses was too high (15.97\%) in WDC 1.0. AS \& FA asked the UT representative to submit the completion reports, end-line evaluation reports of Batch I to III by 28.2.2022 by utilizing the unspent balance of Rs. 57 crore immediately.

## Decision of the Committee:

After detailed deliberations, the Committee appraised and sanctioned 18 projects involving an area of 67,828 ha subject to the condition that the mandatory certificates

Punjab: The Divisional Soil Conservation Officer made presentation in presence of CEO, SLNA in respect of 7 projects covering an area of 28,867 ha against an area of 28,887 ha allocated by DoLR. In addition to the allocated area, the State also presented 2 projects covering an area of 7,224 ha. The State informed that all PRs have been submitted after taking approval of Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman, SLSC, Punjab. It was also informed that all projects are located in kandi areas (submountainous).

## Decision of the Committee:

After detailed deliberations, the Committee appraised and sanctioned 7 projects involving an area of 28,867 ha. The list of projects appraised and sanctioned is at Annexure III.

Uttar Pradesh: The CEO, SLNA made the presentation in respect of 53 projects covering an area of $2,65,761$ ha against an area of $2,64,015$ ha allocated by DoLR. In addition to the allocated area, the State also presented 32 projects covering an area of 1,60,981 ha.

The Chairman, and AS (DoLR) urged the State to strengthen institutional structures and BIAs for implementation of WDC 2.0 and to use GIS tools extensively at planning stage.

The CEO informed that PAs have already been decided and institutional framework will be suitably strengthened for this purpose. He also assured that both unspent amount and accrued interest will be returned to DoLR by 31.1.2022 after making payment for end-line evaluation reports.
After detailed deliberations, the Committee appraised and sanctioned 53 projects subject to the following conditions:


All projects (PPRs) should be approved by SLSC or Chairman (SLSC).
The total area of projects should not exceed the allocated area of $2,64,015$ ha.
Mandatory certificates signed by CEO, SLNA should be enclosed with each PPR.

## Decision of the Committee:

The State has now submitted proposals with the approval of Chairman,SLSC, Uttar Pradesh for all 53 projects and has submitted the revised area of 2,63,961 ha which is apprised and sanctioned by the Committee. The list of the projects apprised and sanctioned are enclosed at Annexure III.

Uttrakhand: The Additional CEO, SLNA made the presentation in respect of 12 projects covering an area of 73,070 ha against an area of 70,271 ha allocated by DoLR. In addition to the allocated area, the State also presented 4 projects covering an area of 29,200 ha located in Haridwar district but each of them had a score of 55 or 60 which is less than the qualifying score of 75 out of 135 marks.

After detailed deliberations, the Committee appraised and sanctioned 12 projects subject to the following conditions:

All projects (PPRs) should be approved by Chairman,SLSC.
The total area of projects should not exceed the allocated area of 70,271 ha.

## Decision of the Committee:

Haryana: The Technical Expert, SLNA made the presentation in respect of 10 projects covering an area of 33,340 ha against an area of 31,221 ha allocated by DoLR. In addition to the allocated area, the State also proposed 3 projects covering an area of 8,615 ha for appraisal by the Committee.

It was noticed that neither State has submitted duly signed copies of PPRs nor they have been approved by SLSC.

## Decision of the Committee:

The Chairman directed the State to submit hard copies of PPR in the prescribed format duly signed by CEO and approved by Chairman, SLSC.
Himachal Pradesh: The CEO, SLNA made the presentation in respect of 31 projects covering an area of 68,000 ha against an area of 54,029 ha allocated by DoLR.

The State has neither submitted duly signed copies of PPR nor obtained approval of SLSC.

## Decision of the Committee:

The Chairman directed the State to submit hard copies of PPR in the prescribed format duly signed by CEO and approved by Chairman, SLSC to DoLR at the earliest.

Ladakh: Director (Rural Development), Ladakh made the presentation in respect of 14 projects covering an area of 30,086 ha against an area of 21,738 ha allocated by DoUR.

It was observed that neither the UT has submitted duly signed copies of PPR nor have they been approved by SLSC.

## Decision of the Committee:

The Chairman directed the UT representative to submit hard copies of PRs in the prescribed format duly signed by CEO and approved by Chairman, SLSC.
6. During presentation by the States/UTs, significant remarks and observations were made by the Chairman, AS (DoLR) and AS\&FA (DoLR) which are summarized below:
(i) Salary/remuneration structure for all manpower employed at SLNA, WCDC, PIA, WDT and WC may be fixed/enhanced by the States/UTs themselves within the overall $10 \%$ ceiling on major head Administrative Expenses.

(ii) Accrued interest on WDC 1.0 funds available should be transferred to DoLR immediately.
(iii) Unspent balance should be utilized expeditiously and the remaining balance should be refunded to DoLR by 31.3.2022.
(iv) All due completion reports/End-line evaluation reports of WDC 1.0 projects should be submitted to DoLR by 28.2.2022/31.3.2022 respectively.
(v) Convergence activities should be reflected/captured in DPR/ MIS / achievements of WDC 2.0 project areas.
(vi) For effective utilization of available time, States/UTs may initiate certain activities i.e. plantation including Horticulture and NRM activities even before finalization of DPR. However, such activities will be necessarily part of the DPR and will strictly comply with the Guidelines of WDC-PMKSY 2.0.
(vii) If the expenditure under Admn. Component exceeds $10 \%$ ceiling, the same is to be borne by State / UT Govt. and should not be charged on WDC 2.0 projects funds.
(viii) States/UTs may urgently assess the actual requirement of the funds and unspent balance if any over and above the requirement should be immediately returned to DoLR.
7. After detailed deliberations, the Committee appraised and sanctioned PPRs as listed at Annexure III.
