MINUTES OF THE STATE LEVEL SANCTIONING COMMITTEE (SLSC)
MEETING OF WATERSHED DEVELOPMENT COMPONENT OF PRADHAN
MANTRI KRISHI SINCHAYEE YOJANA (WDC-PMKSY) HELD AT 10.00AM ON
05.06.2024 IN THE MANAS CONFERENCE HALL, 3RD FLOOR, LOK SEWA
BHAWAN, JANATA BHAWAN, DISPUR, GUWAHATI-06

The State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting on Watershed Development Component of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (WDC-PMKSY) was held in the Manas Conference Hall, 3rd Floor, Lok Sewa Bhawan, Janata Bhawan, Dispur, Guwahati-6 under the Chairmanship of Dr. Ravi Kota, IAS, Chief Secretary, Assam and Chairman, SLSC. He welcomed all the Members present and asked the Chief Executive Officer, SLNA to apprise the House about the purpose / objectives of Watershed Development Component of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (WDC-PMKSY) and give a presentation as per the Agenda.

The Chief Executive Officer, SLNA stated that the DoLR, GoI had sanctioned 29 nos. of Watershed projects for Assam under WDC-PMKSY 2.0 in 2021-22 covering an area of 1,28,574.00 Ha with total project cost of Rs. 293.0028 Cr. for a period of 5 years. And based on the performance of these projects, the DoLR, Govt. of India has additionally sanctioned two new projects in two districts, i.e., Kamrup Metro and Charaideo of Assam in the year 2022-23 for a total treatable area of 8000.00 ha and with project cost of Rs. 17.60 Cr. which was to be immediately launched after MCC for Lok Sabha Election, 2024 is over. Therefore, the total number of WDC-PMKSY projects is 31 with a total amount of Rs 310.6028 Cr. for treatable area of 136574.00 Ha across 30 districts in Assam.

Further, with the permission of the Chair, the CEO, SLNA proceeded with a Power Point Presentation.

1. Approval of the Minutes of the last SLSC meeting:

The Minutes of the last SLSC meeting held on 9th May, 2023 was circulated to all the members of the committee in the meeting. As no objection was raised from any corner, the minutes of the last SLSC meeting was approved by the House.

2. Action taken by SLNA on WDC-PMKSY as per last SLSC Meeting held on $9^{\rm th}$ May, 2023 was presented before the House first :

In the last SLSC meeting held on 9th May 2023, the Committee had approved Annual Action Plan 2023-24 amounting to Rs. 164.57 Cr. including unspent balance of Rs. 17.29 Cr. from the FY 2022-23.

As per Annual Action Plan, the DoLR, GoI had released Rs.108.00 Cr. as Central Share in 4 (four) tranches and Rs 12.00 Cr was received as State Share in the ratio of 90:10. Thus total available fund, including the unspent balance from previous Financial Year Rs.17.29 Cr., was Rs. 137.81 Cr. The expenditure was Rs. 89.30 Cr. and the interest amount of Rs. 0.66 Cr. was refunded to Government. The unspent balance was Rs 47.85 Cr. as on 31st March, 2024.

3. Review on Physical and financial progress under WDC-PMKSY 2.0.

a) Physical Progress:

In the last two financial years, i.e., 2022-23 and 2023-24, the following activities were completed against the target:

The CEO apprised the house that scientific tools like Remote Sensing & GIS, GPS and MIS are being used for effective planning and monitoring of the projects. He also informed that for Monitoring, Evaluation, Learning and Documentation (MEL&D), a Third Party Agency viz. M/s Vision EIS Consulting Pvt. Ltd., Noida, Uttar Pradesh has been engaged.

During discussion, the Chief Secretary, Assam directed the CEO, SLNA to strengthen and enhance monitoring of all completed as well as ongoing schemes under Natural Resource Management (NRM). He also suggested to assess the present status of the assets created under the projects.

The Chief Secretary further directed that the Third Party (MEL&D) Agency engaged for this purpose must visit each and every works and provide genuine inputs in their Quarterly and Annual Reports on the quality, usefulness and effectiveness of the assets created under NRM. The MEL&D agency should highlight success of activities taken up under Production system and Livelihood activities and also to suggest additional requirement of interventions to be taken up by other government Departments. They must present true pictures of the field while submitting the Quarterly and Annual reports for getting approval from the SLNA.

b) Financial Progress:

Under the CSS scheme WDC-PMKSY 2.0, total fund received under both Central & State Share is Rs. 198.33 Cr. Out of which Rs. 170.96 Cr. have been released to 30 districts against 31 nos. of projects. Total expenditure is Rs. 150.48 Cr. by the end of the Financial Year 2023-24 and the expenditure percentage is 76% while the Unspent balance is Rs. 47.85 Cr. which has been carried forward and included in the proposed Annual Action Plan of the Current Financial Year 2024-25.

4. Review and Approval of Annual Acton Plan 2024-25

Thus, Annual Action Plan for **Rs. 158.18 Cr.** for 31 nos. of WDC-PMKSY 2.0 Projects is proposed for the Financial Year 2024-25.

The CEO, SLNA informed the house that as this is the fourth year of on-boarding of the WDC-PMKSY 2.0 projects, except the two new reward projects, viz. Kamrup Metro-I/2022-23 (Barkacharang) and Charaideo-I/2022-23 (Bartimun Nodi), SLNA has planned to complete all the activities under work phase (NRM, Production system & Livelihood) during the financial year of 2024-25. For the two new projects, the process of Land Resource Inventory (LRI) are being conducted with the help of Assam Agricultural University, Jorhat along with another ongoing projects viz. Morigaon - I/2021-22 (Kumoi) for assessing the effectiveness of planning of the project. He also apprised the House that a Handbook on Convergence has been prepared by SLNA which will be finalized shortly and circulated to all the stakeholders.

After a detailed deliberation, the House approved the Annual Action Plan of WDC-PMKSY 2.0 for the Financial Year 2024-25.

5. Any other matter

 Regarding geo-tagging of the activities under WDC-PMKSY 2.0, the Chief Secretary asked CEO, SLNA to pursue the matter of linking the activities captured in the Bhuvan Srishti Portal of WDC-PMKSY with the PM-Gati Shakti National Master Portal to enable integrated planning by different stakeholders with the support of the Secretary, Industries and Commerce & Public Enterprises, and CM's Secretariat, etc., Assam.
